Full, analytic treatment of the Supreme Court's decisions in the Affordable Care Act is presented. Coverage of the preemption doctrine is expanded. A new discussion of the Religion Clauses' treatment considers church autonomy in light of *Hosanna-Tabor*. The text on freedom of expression has been revised to incorporate new cases such as *Citizens United v*. *Federal Election Commission* (on campaign finance regulation), *Snyder v. Phelps* (on intentional infliction of emotional distress), *Brown v. Entertainment Merchants Ass'n* (on violent video games), *FCC v. Fox Television Stations* (on expletives in broadcasting), and *United States v. Alvarez* (on criminal liability for lying about receiving medals of honor.) New material on privacy and the Internet brings the **Seventh Edition** completely up to date.
